

Dorm Information for 2002 Masters Nationals Swimmers

Aloha Masters Swimmers!

For those of you who are interested in staying in the dorms at UH, here is some more detailed information, as well as payment instruction. We have reserved 50 dorm rooms. The first 50 rooms reserved and **paid in full** will be accepted. We can accept reservations until March 22nd or until all the rooms are booked, whichever comes first. Dorms and the cafeteria are a 5 minute walk to the pool.

Availability of Dorm Rooms

Dorms will be available May 12, 2002 after 2:00 p.m. for check in. You must check out by May 19, 2002 by 12:00 noon.

“Amenities” – Dorm Style!

Each dorm room has a bed, desk, study chair and wastebasket. All rooms accommodate two people, but may be used as a single. Bathroom facilities are shared with others on the floor and are segregated by sex.

A telephone is provided in each dormitory and apartment from which local calls may be made without charge. Access to long-distance dialing may be arranged by applying for a private authorization code after your arrival, but it is preferred that conferees bring their own calling cards. A deposit is required for the provision of long-distance service.

Bed linen, including two sheets, a pillow with pillowcase, a bed pad, wash cloths, bath towel, hotel size soap and a few hangers are provided. Bed linens and towels are exchanged on a weekly basis, so plan to keep the same ones all week. Blankets are available upon request at the front desk.

Card operated washers (\$1.50/cycle) and dryers (\$1.25/cycle) are available on site. A color TV is provided in the main lounge. All public areas are cleaned daily, but not individual rooms. Vacuum cleaners are loaned at the front desk.

Please be aware that services typically available in hotels are not provided in the dorms. None of the dorms are air-conditioned, neither bellhops nor room service is available, some buildings do not have elevators, and child-care service is not available.

Alcoholic Beverages

Hawaii state law requires a person to be 21 years or older to consume alcoholic beverages. Dorm policy permits the consumption of alcoholic beverages, but only in the privacy of a resident’s room. These policies are strictly monitored and violators face immediate eviction from the premises.

Meals

All residents are required to participate in a meal program, Monday through Friday. Meals are in the dining hall, cafeteria style. The daily menus include a selection of entrees, one of which is vegetarian. In addition, an assortment of salads, desserts, and beverages are offered. **Weekend meals are not mandatory.** You will be able to purchase weekend meals on campus at the door. The dorm cafeteria is a 5 minute walk to the pool. Hours of operation are: Breakfast & Lunch 7a.m. – 2 p.m. Dinner 4:30 p.m – 9 p.m. Friday nights the cafeteria closes at 8:00 p.m.

The following plans are available, and you must choose **one plan for your entire stay**, except for arrival days and departure days which are pro-rated. No refunds are given for meals not attended. You must include the appropriate meals for your arrival and departure days, if Monday through Friday. See hours above.

Security Deposit

Each person must pay a security deposit of \$25. This deposit will be returned within 6 – 8 weeks of departure, assuming no damage is done to the room and no linens or keys are missing.

After Hours Arrival

If you are going to arrive or depart between 9:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m., you must let us know in advance, and a \$25 fee will be applied, per group (not per person). If you do not know this information at the time of the reservation, that is fine. Just let us know as soon as you make your travel arrangements.

Parking

Parking is available for \$3/day in the parking structure, a 5 minute walk from the dorms.

Rates and Deadlines

Rates for the dorm rooms are as follows:

- \$40/day per room. If two people share the room, no additional daily fees are required.
- \$25 per **person** security deposit, to be returned 6 – 8 weeks after check-out.
- Meal fees, starting at \$10.04/day on weekdays.

Optional fees, as needed

- \$25 after hours check-in or check-out (see above)
- \$3/day parking fee
